

# ALL ABOARD A WIDER RAIL NETWORK

By 2020, the total rail network will double from 138km to 278 km with new lines and extensions. The Downtown and Circle lines will also open earlier.



- 2009** Circle Line 3 (Marymount, Bishan, Lor Chuan, Serangoon, Bartley) opens
- 2010** Rest of Circle Line opens
- 2012** Circle Line extension in Marina
- 2013** Downtown line 1 complete
- 2015** Downtown line 2, North South Line and Tuas extensions
- 2016** Downtown line 3 complete
- 2018** Thomson Line opens (see map)
- 2020** Eastern Region Line opens (see map)

## KEY CHANGES

- » Faster trips: 93 extra train trips a week at peak hours from next month
- » New trains and better infrastructure in four years' time, with peak waiting time of two minutes
- » Better facilities and access for pedestrians and the disabled
- » Competition: Operators' licences to be reduced from the existing 30 years to 10-15 years
- » New financing framework will see new lines being built where needed if the entire rail network is profitable
