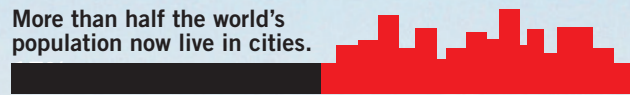


MORE CITIES, FASTER GROWTH, GREATER PRESSURE ON RESOURCES

30 years ago.

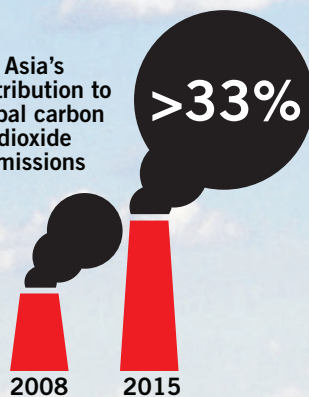
Asian cities are becoming
