

» ROADS CLOSED IN PHASES

Roads in the City Hall and Marina Centre area will be closed in the days leading up to the Formula One race on Sept 26 to 28. Here is what to expect if you are travelling there



Areas closed to traffic

- Sept 20 (9am) to Oct 2 (5am)
- Sept 23 (midnight) to 30 (5am)
- Sept 26 (9am) to 29 (5am)

Republic Boulevard will reopen on Oct 1, 5am

Roads open to traffic

- Open on Sept 23 to 27 from 5am to 9am and Sept 29 onwards
- Sept 23 to 26 from 5am to 9am and Oct 1 onwards

- Existing taxi stand
- Shuttle bus stop
- Temporary taxi stand
- Temporary overhead bridge

If you drive

- » Roads in the area will close gradually in three phases, each represented by a different colour above
- » Three of the four lanes of Nicoll Highway and the stretch from Republic Avenue to Raffles Avenue will be open to Shenton Way-bound traffic during morning peak hours on some days
- » Special access passes will be given to those who have season parking lots in buildings affected by road closures as well as hotel guests

If you take public transport

- » Trains passing by City Hall MRT station will run at an increased frequency of 2 to 3 minutes before and after races
- » All pedestrian underpasses like CityLink Mall and existing overhead bridges in the area will remain open
- » Shuttle buses to Suntec City will be available outside Bugis and City Hall MRT stations, running at a frequency of 10 to 12 minutes, from 6.30am to midnight on Sept 20 to 25 and Sept 29, and from 6.30am to 7pm on Sept 16 to 28
- » Marina Centre Bus Terminal will close and 26 bus services will be diverted

If you take a taxi

- » Taxis can drop off passengers at taxi stands at Suntec City and Millenia Tower and Conrad Hotel's driveway, even on race days
- » Taxis without passengers will not be allowed into the area
- » Only taxis with passengers holding special access passes will be allowed into the underground carpark of Marina Square

If you are a F1 race ticket holder

- » Shuttle buses for ticket holders will be available at Kallang, Lavender, Outram Park and Clarke Quay MRT stations. These will make stops near gates to the race track.
