

IRAN PROTESTS

Thousands of supporters of Iran's defeated presidential candidate Mirhossein Mousavi marched in Tehran on Tuesday following a disputed poll prompting the biggest street protests since the 1979 Islamic revolution

Witnesses said Mousavi supporters headed here largely in silence without the accustomed chants. The facility was ringed with riot police, according to witnesses

Vali-ye Asr St.

Riot police moved up the boulevard while demonstrators clapped their hands in defiance and traffic was blocked. At one point, 100 protestors sat on the road

Ahmadinejad supporters mobilised thousands of demonstrators where Mousavi's supporters had planned to gather again Tuesday despite a ban on the opposition rally
