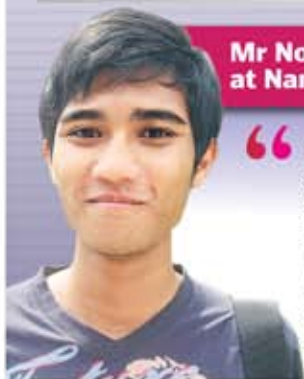


Ms Nurain Amin, 17, student at Republic Polytechnic
