
then. He has been electric in his last four appearances. He will look to dart around and past Morgan and Robert Huth, but Leicester have five clean sheets in six games.



Yaya Toure v N'Golo Kante

Toure has been tipped to leave when Pep Guardiola arrives so this season could be his send-off. When he joined in 2010, it was with a reputation as a defensive midfielder. Now he is an

attacking presence whereas Kante, who has made the most tackles and interceptions in the Premier League this season, really shields the back four.



Martin Demichelis v Jamie Vardy

Another duel where a quick striker will look to expose a slower centre-back. Demichelis had a dreadful start to the season but has performed better of late and has become vital in Vincent

Kompany's absence. Yet Vardy's movement makes him the most elusive of opponents while Claudio Ranieri this week likened his volley to Marco van Basten's greatest goal.
