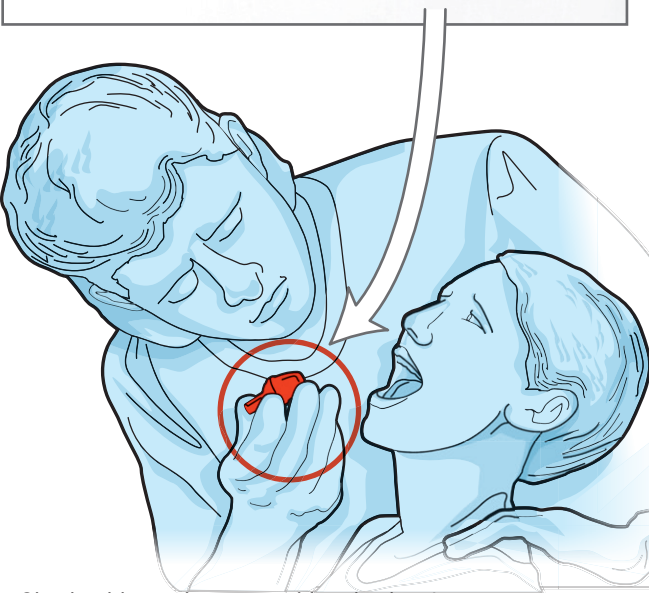
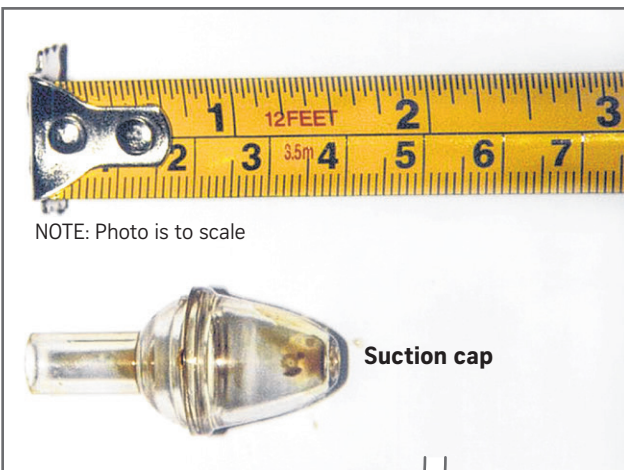


What happened that day

9.13am

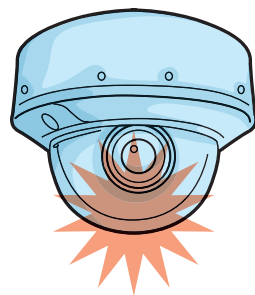
- Indonesian maid Kusrini Caslan Arja, 37, inserts a suction cap into the four-year-old boy's mouth to remove phlegm.



- She had been instructed by the boy's parents to use the cap only outside the boy's nose and mouth, not inside.
- She soon realises the cap has dropped into his throat and uses her fingers to try and dig it out.

9.13am to 9.15am

- Kusrini digs forcefully into the boy's mouth and throat until his face turns purple.
- In scenes captured by a CCTV camera placed near the boy's bed, she is seen inserting her entire hand into his mouth and throat, causing him to bleed profusely.



9.22am

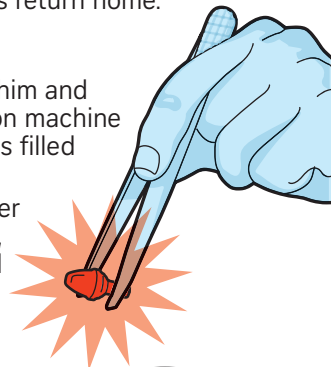
- Failing to retrieve the cap, Kusrini stops digging into the boy's mouth and throat.
- His father later calls to check on his son. She tells him the boy is fine.

7pm

The boy's parents return home.

9.15pm

- They check on him and realise the suction machine pump container is filled with blood.
- The boy's mother opens his mouth, sees the cap and removes it with a pair of tweezers.



9.19pm

- The couple call for an ambulance and alert the police.
- The boy is taken to KK Women's and Children's Hospital.
