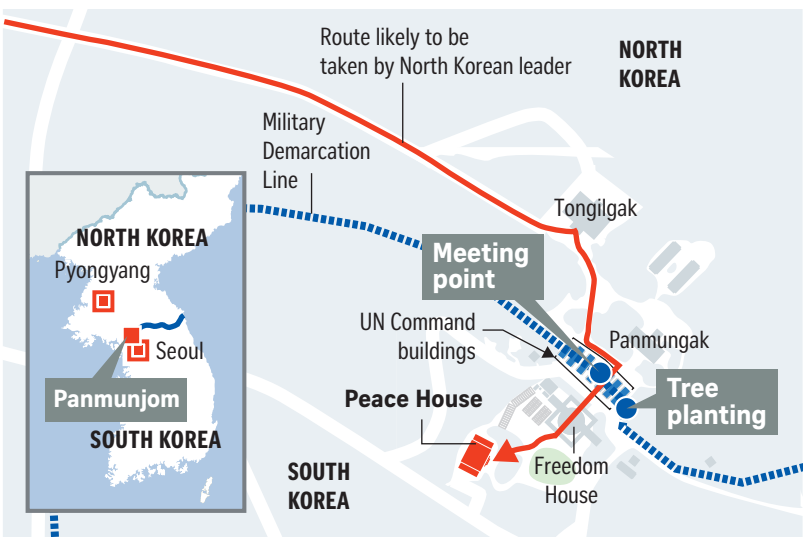


Kim's programme



- North Korean leader Kim Jong Un is likely to get off the car at Tongilgak (Unification Pavilion) or Panmungak (North Korea office building) within the Demilitarised Zone (DMZ)
- Mr Kim to cross the Military Demarcation Line (MDL) by foot at around 9.30am Seoul time (8.30am Singapore time) today. He will be greeted by South Korean President Moon Jae In.
- Both leaders will be escorted by South Korean honour guards to a welcome ceremony at a plaza between Freedom House and Peace House
- Dialogue to begin at 10.30am (Seoul time) at the Peace House
- After the morning session of talks, the North's delegation will cross back to its side for lunch
- After lunch, both leaders will plant a pine tree close to the Military Demarcation Line
- Leaders to take a stroll around Panmunjom before resuming the afternoon session of talks at the Peace House
- After the summit meeting, the two leaders will sign an agreement and announce what could be called the Panmunjom Declaration
- South Korea to host Mr Kim and his delegation to dinner from around 6.30pm (Seoul time), followed by a farewell ceremony
