Primarily raised in France by French-Dominican parents, French jazz singer Cyrille Aimee was a curious child in Samois-sur-Seine, discovering gypsy music after sneaking out through her bedroom window and wandering around nearby gypsy encampments. She went on to sing on the streets in Europe and found herself at the Montreux Jazz Festival in 2007, where she won first prize in the vocal competition, which kick-started her jazz career.

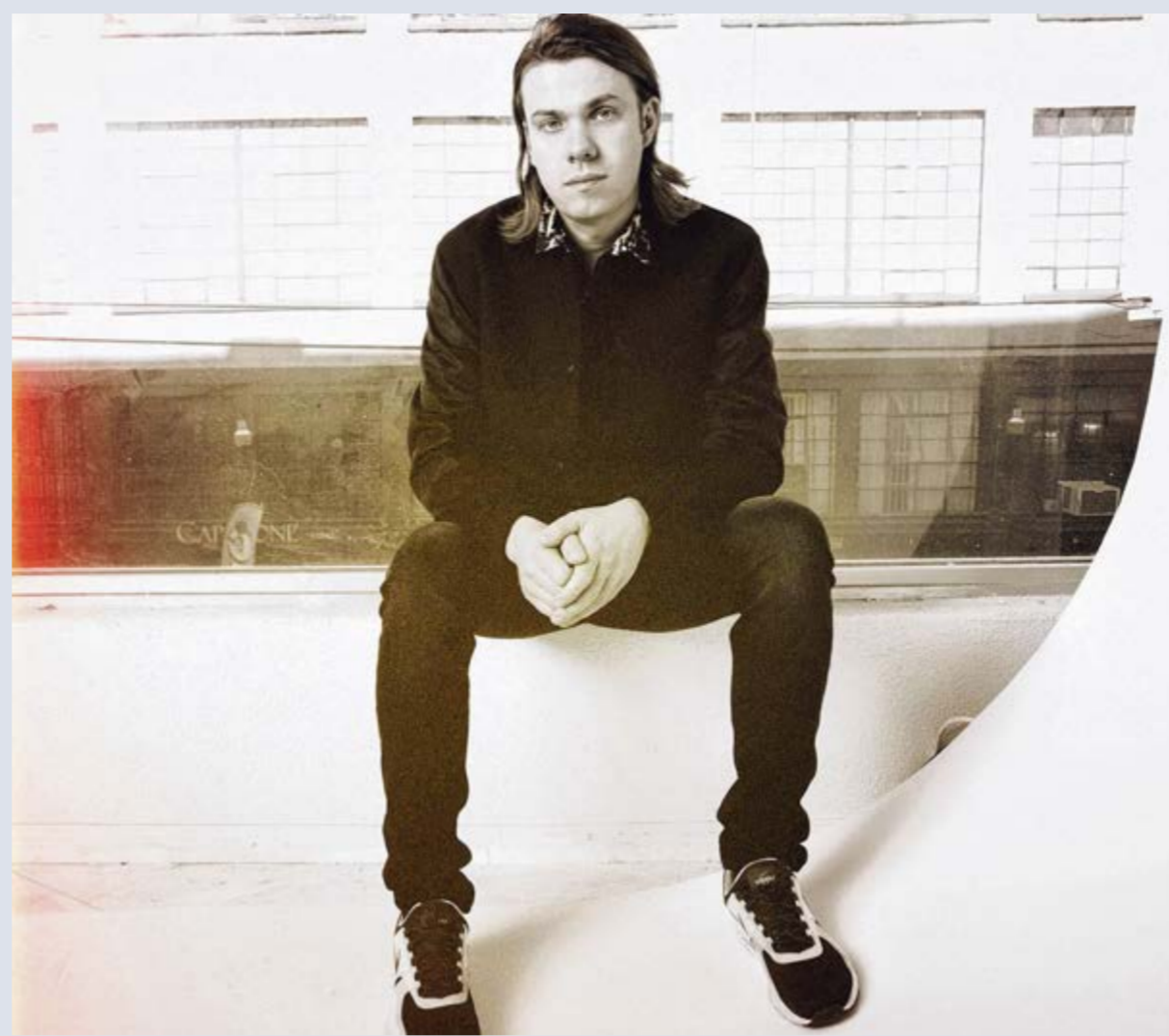
