

# What the Networked Trade Platform can do

As a one-stop trade and logistics platform for companies, the new service aims to combine all Customs clearance and trade-related services, digitalising the paper-based processes used by the industry. Here is what you can do.



## Manage trade documents digitally

Documents required for trade clearance can be uploaded and stored on the platform's cloud-based servers. These documents can be seamlessly, swiftly and securely shared with business partners or government organisations when needed. Users get five gigabytes of storage space.



## Use government services

Trade declarations, permit management and other services that are required for conducting trade in and out of Singapore can be done through the platform. Four services are available currently, with more being introduced later.



## Build applications

The open nature of the platform allows users to design and build applications that can be offered on it, using the provided developer tools.



## Engage business partners and networks

Companies can add their business partners onto the platform, and can choose to access the same data repository of trade documents to support their business transactions. Blogs, forums and communities enable trade-based discussions on trends, best practices and opportunities.



## Connect with third-party commercial services

The platform has an online marketplace that showcases value-added services created by third-party providers, ranging from invoice financing to insurance and logistics management. A total of 25 providers are now on the platform, with around 90 more on the way.
